“The idea of the Foundation grew from the realities we witnessed in rural Chhattisgarh. Many elderly people living in distant villages were suffering from treatable eye conditions but had no access to medical care. One particular case that stayed with us was that of an elderly woman in her eighties living in a remote village. She had lost much of her vision due to cataract but had no means to travel to the city for treatment. When we were able to restore her sight, it made us realize how many more people were silently living with avoidable blindness. That experience strengthened our resolve to create an organization that could reach people where they live. The Foundation was established so that no person is denied eye care due to distance or financial constraints.”

“For many years, I witnessed patients suffering from corneal diseases who could not afford treatment. THE CHALLENGE

After the loss of her husband, Dulmat Bai faced financial hardship and relied on labor work to support herself. Due to cataracts, her vision became very weak, making it difficult for her to earn and manage daily life.

OUR INTERVENTION

During an eye screening camp in her village, our team examined her eyes and diagnosed cataracts. She was counseled and provided with free cataract surgery at Shri Ganesh Vinayak Eye Hospital, Raipur.

THE IMPACT

The surgery was successful and her vision was restored. Today, Dulmat Bai can see clearly and carry out her daily activities with confidence and independence.

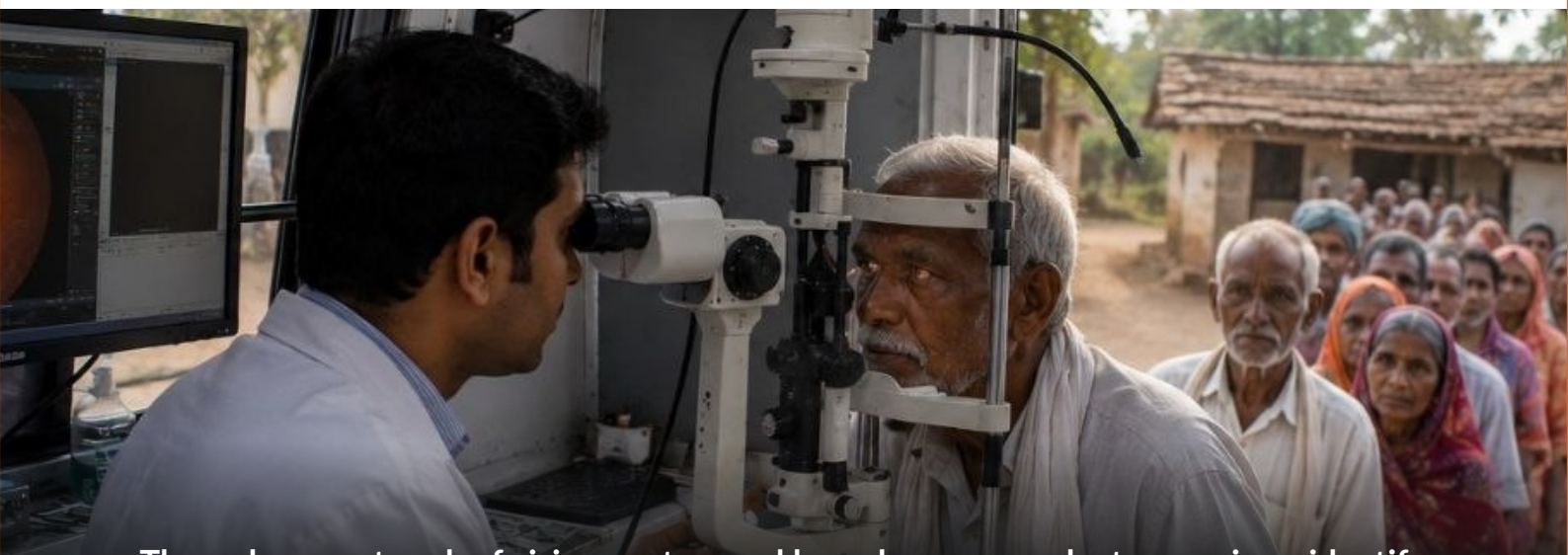
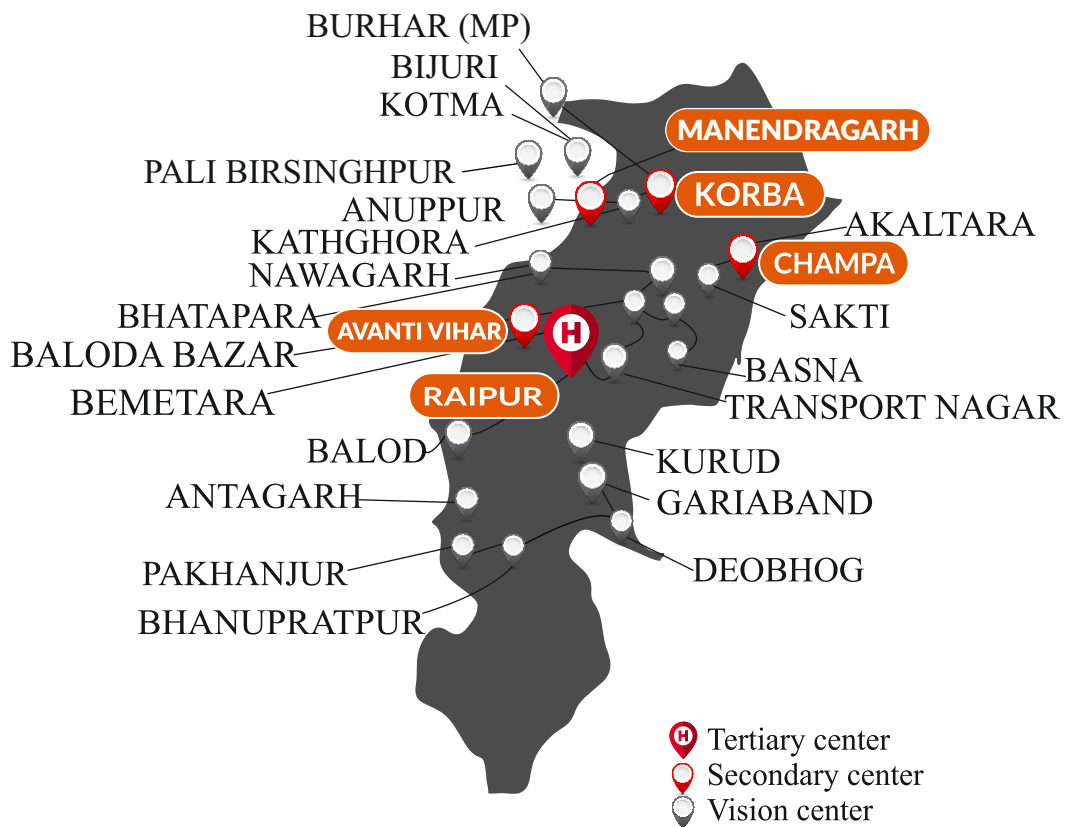

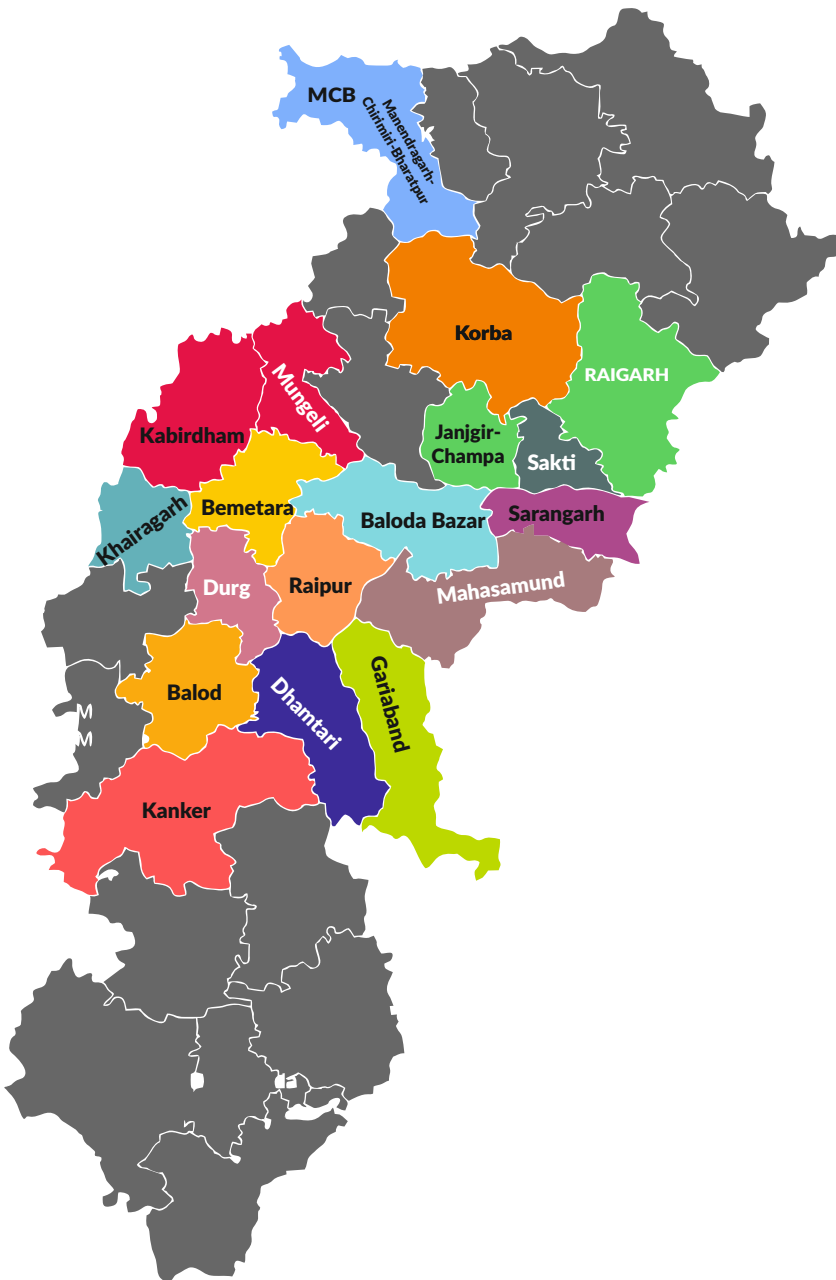

How We Work



1. Community Screening and Patient Identification

Shri Ganesh Vinayak Foundation works closely with Shri Ganesh Vinayak Eye Hospital to provide quality eye care services to underserved communities. Through vision centres, branch facilities, and mobile eye care vans, primary eye screening is conducted in villages, towns, and remote areas across Chhattisgarh. Trained teams identify individuals with vision problems and refer patients requiring advanced diagnosis or surgical treatment.



2. Referral and Hospital-Based Care

Patients requiring further treatment are transported to Shri Ganesh Vinayak Eye Hospital by the Foundation. At the hospital, they undergo detailed eye examinations and necessary pre-operative tests, including blood pressure and blood sugar checks, to ensure they are fit for surgery. Patients requiring cataract or other eye surgeries receive treatment from experienced ophthalmic surgeons.



3. Financial Support for Patients

The Foundation supports patients from underserved communities by covering the costs of treatment, medicines, food, accommodation, and transportation. This assistance ensures that financial limitations do not become a barrier to receiving quality eye care services.



4. Mobile Eye Care and Outreach Programs

Mobile eye care vans conduct screening camps in remote villages, helping detect vision problems early and connecting patients to the complete treatment pathway, including diagnosis, surgery, and follow-up care. The Foundation also runs various eye health programs through which thousands of people receive eye screenings, spectacles, and surgical treatment every year.



5. Collaborative Impact

The success of this model is driven by the combined efforts of Shri Ganesh Vinayak Eye Hospital, the Foundation, CSR partners, social organizations, and individual donors. Together, they ensure that quality eye care reaches those who need it most, restoring vision and improving lives across communities.

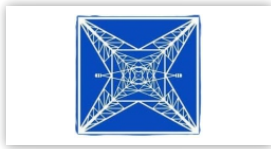

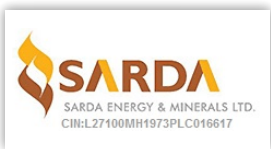

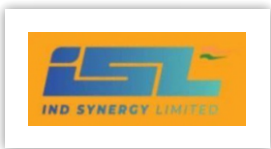
